MONTAGNE SAINT-EMILION APPELLATION MONTAGNE SAINT-EMILION CONTROLES



This wine is made from a single hectare of Merlot situated in the village of Montagne Saint Emilion, 750 meters north of Château Cheval Blanc.

This cuvee has always completed the range of wines of Château Moncets. Today it represents the purity of this single grape varietal from one of the most beautiful terroirs of the Right Bank.

BLENDING

100% Merlot

TERROIR

Area: **1,14 hectares** Soil: Sandy dark clay Planting density: 6000 vine stocks / ha 1 plot planted in 1929

WINEGROWING

Under conversion to **organic** 4 ways of grass growing : **earthing / unearthing Drones** used for balancing soils with **selected grasses**. **Hand harvest**

WINEMAKING

Gravity flow cellar 2 Grape sorting tables : AIRBLOW (blowing) + DREAM (bath) 1 Italian concrete tank for low temperatures maceration Aged 6 months in tank

TASTING NOTES

Deep garnet color. Wonderful quality fruit on the nose recalling ripe red and black berry fruits.

The palate is pleasantly mellow and showcases tangy focused fruit and spice aromas.
