The Château de Chambrun vineyard extends over 5 distinct locations, all in the commune of Néac, a direct extension of the Pomerol plateau.

We acquired this property in 2015 and then purchased several additional plots on this prestigious plateau, bringing our estate to more than 10 hectares today.

#### **BLENDING**

79% Merlot & 21% Cabernet Franc

## **TERROIR**

Area: 12.24 hectares

Soil: Gravelly clay
On surface: Gravel

Planting density: 6500 pieds / ha

Average age of the vines: about 52 years

### **WINEGROWING**

15 plots and as many cultural process.In transition to Organic vineyard for 2 yearsNatural grass cover combined with cover crop

#### **VINIFICATION**

Densimetric sorting table (densibaie)
Grape reception with a gravity flow cellar
New generation of thermo regulated vats for plot selection
Aged 18 months in french oak barrels, 12 different toasting
from 5 barrel makers: 80% of new oak & 20% of 1 year old oak

# **TASTING NOTE**

A subtle and filigree bouquet! This wine displays nuances of blackberry as well as a touch of dried herbs. Fine and tight tannins which are in phase with the freshness of the acid structure. A juicy wine.
